You can move this widget to any section of the screen




Make sure Full screen is selected




Click the Record button to begin Recording the entire screen

You can verify microphone activity by Right Clicking on the volume icon on the taskbar and selecting Recording devices


The active microphone device will light up when you speak into the microphone. Be sure to set that device as the Default Recording Device



Notice the little REC icon that appears in the top left of the screen.





This indicates the screen is being recorded.
